It is further covenanted and agreed that should the rent hereinbefore reserved remain unpaid for a period of thirty days after the same shall be due and payable, in accordance with the terms hereof, the failure of said lessee to pay said rent within said thirty day period shall, at the option of the lessor, terminate this agreement.
