aforesaid, to have, hold, exercise and enjoy the said office
of member of Committee aforesaid, to gether with all the
rights, privileges, profits and emoluments whatsoever there-
unto belonging, & in any wise appertaining.

This commission is to continue in force for the term pro-
vided by law (two years).
