Pressly, member of the Overbrook Water and Sewer Sub-District Committee, in the State aforesaid, to have, hold, exercise and enjoy the said office of member of Committee aforesaid, together with all the rights, privileges, profits and emoluments whatsoever thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining.

This commission is to continue in force for the term provided by law. (Two years).
