all that place, parcel or lot of land in XXXX, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.
being one and a half miles from the Greenville County Court House and near the Finlay
Bridge on continuation of Hampton Avenue and being a part of lot No. 23 of Marshall's
Addition to the City of Greenville, as shown by plat prepared by J. W. Southern, Dec.
21, 1897, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book "B" page
658 and having the following rates and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a stake on Monroe Street, running thence N. 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. along line of lot
No. 22, 340 feet to a stake; thence along line of lot No. 14, S. 45.00 W. 53 feet to
center of lot No. 23; thence S. 39.00 S. 354 feet, more or less, to Monroe Street;
thence with Monroe Street 58 feet to the beginning corner, being approximately one-half
of lot No. 23, heretofore referred to.

This deed is an absolute conveyance of title in effect as well as form and is now
intended as a mortgage, trust conveyance or security of any kind. The consideration
therefor is full release of all deeds, notes, obligations, costs and charges heretofore
subsisting on account and by the terms of that certain mortgage heretofore existing on
the property herein conveyed, executed by A. S. Lockee to Peoples Building and Loan
Association, recorded in Book 203, Page 69 of the official records of Greenville County,
this conveyance completely satisfying said obligation and terminating said mortgage and
the note secured thereby and any effect thereof in all respects.

As a part of the consideration the grantee herein agrees to satisfy the mortgage
executed by A. S. Lockee on November 19, 1928, in the sum of Eleven Hundred (\$1100.00)
Dollars covering the above described property, which mortgage has been assumed by John
A. Johnston.
