day of June 1934 and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a _____ Decree

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of
Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars
to me paid by the said John W. Norwood, Jr.

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said
John W. Norwood, Jr.

All that certain lot of land, situate in Greenville Township, State and County aforesaid, on the Southern side of Nelson Street, the southeasterly corner of Nelson Street and Burnett Avenue, in the City of Greenville, being Lot No. 54 and a portion (4 feet) of lot No. 55 of Washington Heights subdivision according to a plat made by C.M. Furman, Jr., February 3, 1922, and recorded in Plat Book "F", Page 54; said lot being more fully described as follows: Beginning at a point the southeastern corner of Nelson Street and Burnett Avenue; thence in a southwesterly direction with the line of Burnett Avenue 37.95 feet to the corner of Lot No. 66, thence in a southeasterly direction with the line of Lot No. 66, 39 feet; thence in a northeasterly direction parallel with and four feet east of line of Lots Nos. 54 and 55 to a point on Nelson Street four feet east of the corner of lots Nos. 54 and 55; thence in a northwesterly direction with Nelson Street 40 feet to the beginning corner.
