I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, W. P. Doyle,

on or about the 15th day of September in the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty four exhibited his complaint in the Court of
Common Pleas for the County aforesaid, against D. L. Norris, Individually, et c. at al.

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 17th
day of October 1934 and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court will appear; and the Master, after having duly advertised the said real estate

for sale by public outcry on the 5th day of November in the year of our Lord
nineteen hundred and thirty four did then openly and publicly, according to the custom of auctions, sell and
dispose of the same unto Lila S. Doyle

for the sum of Nine thousand (\$9000.00)
being at that price the highest bidder therefor. Dollars.

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of
Nine thousand (\$9000.00) Dollars
to me paid by the said Lila S. Doyle

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said
Lila S. Doyle

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the North side of Main Street, in Ward One of the City of Greenville, having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a stake on Main Street corner of John B. Weir's lot and running thence N. 18 1/3 E. 90 1/2 feet to a stake on Mooney's line; thence N. 70 1/2 W. 227 feet to a stake; thence S. 13 1/2 W. 115 1/2 feet to a stake; corner Thomas Sloan's property and John B. Weir's property; thence S. 80 E. about 227 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot of land conveyed to D. O. McLin by deed dated October 1, 1919, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 57, Page 208."

Less, however, a strip of land conveyed to J. A. Piper by D. O. McLin by deed dated May 26, 1924, and recorded in Vol. 108, Page 124."
