NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of
One thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars
to me paid by the said Planters Savings Bank of Greer, S. C., a Corporation,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said
Planters Savings Bank of Greer, S. C., a Corporation.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Chick Springs Township, County and State aforesaid, on the National Highway leading from Taylors, S. C., to Greenville, S. C., same being a part of the Robert Gibson Estate, containing nine tenths (9/10) of one acre, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds and marks, viz; Beginning at a corner at a junction of the State Highway and road leading pass the residence now or formerly of M. P.
