J. T. Bramlett for and during his natural life; all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land containing Thirty-four and one-third (34 1/3) acres, more or less, situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, on the East branch of Kilder's Creek, waters of Enoree River, having the following courses and distances, to-wit:
