Whereas, W. A. Seybt and R. E. Barton have been conducting a stationery and office supply business under the firm name of W. A. Seybt & Company; and

Whereas, the parties hereto have agreed upon a dissolution of the said partnership and of the settlement to be made between them on such dissolution, now therefore, this agreement W I T N E S S E T H :

1. That R. E. Barton, in consideration of the payment hereinafter set forth, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and release unto W. A. Seybt, his heirs and assigns, all of his right, title and interest of every nature and kind by, in and to the stock of goods, fixtures, notes, accounts cash in bank, good will and all other assets of every nature and kind of the said partnership.

2. In consideration of the transfer of the assets of W. A. Seybt & Company by R. E. Barton, as set forth in the preceding paragraph, the said W. A. Seybt does hereby agree to pay to said R. E. Barton the sum of One thousand Thirty-three and 02/100 (\$1033.02) Dollars, said sum to be paid as follows: \$33.02 in cash at the time of the execution of this agreement; \$166.66 on December 10, 1934 and \$166.66 on the 10th day of each and every month thereafter until the full amount hereof is paid; with interest on the unpaid balance at the rate of six per cent. per annum until paid. It is agreed that the said W. A. Seybt shall have the right to anticipate payment of the whole or any part of said balance at any time.

3. It is mutually agreed that upon the execution of this contract the partnership, heretofore existing between the parties hereto shall be dissolved; that the said R. E. Barton shall have no longer any interest therein and shall not be in any way liable thereafter for any of the indebtedness of said partnership and that from the date of the execution of this agreement the said W. A. Seybt shall be the sole owner of the said business and shall be liable for all of the indebtedness thereof and assume liability for such indebtedness.
