J. B. Barber and Clarence A. Feeler,
 All that lot, tract or parcel of lands, located on west
 side of St. Mark Road in Hickory Springs Township,
 County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, adjoining
 lands of Ben Miles estate on the east, Lot no. 2 of
 subdivision of E. L. Barber lands on the south, Alex
 Findley lands on the west, and other lands of E. L.
 Barber on the north, and designated as Lot no.
 3 & 4 of subdivisions of E. L. Barber lands and
 having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning on west side of gully on east side of
 plantation road on Alex Findley lands thence N. 51 $\frac{1}{4}$
 E. 360 chains to S. P. in field south of turn in fence
 of E. L. Barber's pasture, thence N. 18 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 70 of a chain
 to S. P. of pasture fence, thence N. 59 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 824 chains
 to point in public road in front of Ben Miles house,
 thence S. 21 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 218 chains to point in west edge of
 St. Mark Road, thence S. 59 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 1121 chains to S. P. on
 east edge of plantation road, the beginning corner, and
 designated as Lot no. 3 in subdivision of E. L. Barber
 lands, and containing three and thirty-two hundredths
 acres (3.32) more or less according to survey made by J.
 Earle Freeman Oct. 30, 1933.

Also that other lot or parcel of land known as
 Lot no. 4 of subdivision of E. L. Barber lands having
 the following metes and bounds: Beginning on S. P.
 on south edge of E. L. Barber's yard near his house
 house, thence N. 61 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 150 chains to S. P. in edge of yard
 thence N. 34 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 75 of a chain to S. P. on edge of
 road thence N. 62 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 122 of a chain to S. P. on edge
 of road, thence N. 76 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 470 to middle of St. Mark
 Road, thence S. 31 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 308 chains to S. P. on west edge
 of St. Mark Road, thence S. 59 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 824 chains to
 stone near fence, thence N. 12 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 332 chains to the
 beginning corner and containing two and twenty-three
 (2.93) acres more or less according to survey made by
 J. Earle Freeman Jan. 16, 1934.
