All that piece, parcel or tract of land, lying and being in Glassy Mountain Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on both sides come of the head branches of Green Creek, a water of South Saluda River, as follows:

Lockhart (declared) corner near the dwelling house running thence S. 28 E. 9.20 chs to a stone; thence S. 43 E. 2.50 chs to a stone, thence S. 88 W. 6.50 chs to a stone thence N. 75 1/2 W. 13.08 chs to a stone, thence N. 14 E. 9.86 chs to a stone, thence North about 53 E. 17.50 chs to a stone; thence N. 61 E. 7.87 chs to a stone; thence N. 57 E. 7.40 chs to a chestnut tree; thence S. 30 W. 8.25 chs to a white oak; thence S. 21 E. 17.40 chs to the beginning corner, containing forty-four (44) acres, more or less, adjoining lands of W.
