All my right, title and interest in and to all those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on Argonne Drive and Paris Road in Avalon, being known and designated as Lots 18, 19 and 20 of the C. B. Martin sub-division, and having, according to plat made by Dalton & Nevas, Engineers, April 1926, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

Beginning at an iron pin at the Southeast corner of the intersection of Paris Road and Argonne Drive, and running thence with Paris Road N. 69° 50' E. 116.5 feet to an iron pin where Paris Road intersects a 20 ft. alley; thence S. 71° 35' E. 130.7 feet to an iron pin on said alley; thence S. 41° 10' E. 33.3 feet to an iron pin; thence with line of lot No. 17, S. 43° 50' W. 173 feet to an iron pin on the Eastern side of Argonne Drive; thence with said Argonne Drive N. 41° 10' W. 236.8 feet to the beginning corner.

The interest herein conveyed is the same inherited by me from my daughter, Osra C. Loggins, deceased, as one of her heirs at law.
