

## Declaration and Petition for Incorporation,

State of South Carolina,  
County of Greenville.

To the Secretary of State of South Carolina:

Under and pursuant to Article 4, Sections 8074, and 8076, Code of 1932, and Amendments thereto the undersigned petitioners C. S. Singletary, Greenville, S. C., Lucille Singletary, Greenville, S. C., Hyman Clark, Greenville, S. C., Blanch Major, Greenville, S. C., Marguerite Lynch, Greenville, S. C., Flora K. Pratt, Greenville, S. C., W. F. Blakely, Greenville, S. C., Annabell O. Tollison, Greenville, S. C., S. E. Colvin, Jr., Greenville, S. C., Emma Lou Hooks, Greenville, S. C., by this their Declaration would respectfully show:

1st. That their names and residences are as above given.

2nd. The name of the proposed corporation which they desire to form is South Atlantic Mutual Life Insurance Company.

3d. The place at which it proposes to have its principal place of business or to be located, is Greenville, South Carolina.

4th. The general nature of the business which it proposes to do is to enable its members and all who may hereafter become members to indemnify each other by insuring the lives and health of the members against death or disability by accident or disease; to render employment services to its members, and all other powers conferred by section 8073 et seq of the 1932 Code of Laws of South Carolina upon mutual protective associations.
