To the Secretary of State of South Carolina

Under and pursuant to Article 4, Sections 8074 and 8076, Code of 1932 and Amendments thereto the undersigned petitioners who are also directors, namely:

by this their Declaration would respectfully show:

- 1st. That their names and residences are as above given.
- 2d. The name of the proposed corporation which they desire to form is Union Bleachery Mutual Benefit Association, Inc.,
- 3d. The place at which it proposes to have its principal place of business, or to be located, is Greenville, S. C.
- 4th. The general nature of the business which it proposes to do is to aid the members of the corporation or their beneficiaries in times of sickness and in death by leaving equitable assessments for the payment of sick relief or death benefits and to make loans to members from the surplus of the Corporation upon such conditions and regulations as may be prescribed by the Corporation and to do all other acts and things as are permitted by law.
- 5th. The purpose of the organization is to enable its members to indemnify each other against the loss specified in the contract made and to enforce such contracts in accordance with the laws of the State and its Constitution and By-Laws.
