TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Grace McH. Mauldin, and her heirs and assigns,

forever:

All those three certain lots of land, with the improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the North side of Detroit Street, in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown and delineated as Lots Nos. 2, 4 and 6 as shown on plat of the property of Oscar K. and John McH. Mauldin made by C. H. Furman, Engineer, in June, 1924, recorded in Plat Book "F" at Page 237, each of said lots having a frontage of 45-8 feet on the Northern side of Detroit Street, with a depth of 186-4 feet.
