(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

R. S. Ballenger,
All my one-third undivided interest in the following described property:
All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situated, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, about three (3) miles northwest of Greenville Courthouse in sub-division known as "Chelsea", and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a point on the north side of Paris Mountain Avenue, distant 243 1/2 feet from the northwest corner of the intersection of Paris Mountain Avenue and Beason Street, W. J. Langston corner and running thence in a northerly direction Parallel with line of W. J. Langston, 380 feet, more or less, to Arlington Avenue, thence with south side of Arlington Avenue, 121 feet to a stake; thence in a southerly direction on a line parallel with first line, 380 feet to a point on northern side of Paris Mountain Avenue; thence with northern line of Paris Mountain Avenue, 121 feet to beginning corner.

Being same piece, parcel or lot of land conveyed to the grantor and grantee by Label M. Ligon, by deed dated Feb. 5, 1925. Recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 77, at page 208.

Also: All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the State and County aforesaid, about three (3) miles northwest of the Greenville Court House, in sub-division known as "Chelsea", containing one and 46/100 acres, more or less and having the following metes and bounds; beginning at the corner of Franklin Road and Arlington Avenue and running thence with said Arlington Avenue N. 83-45 E. 390 feet to a stake; thence S. 6-15 E. 180 feet to a stake; thence S. 83-45 W. 326 feet to a stake on the Franklin Road; thence with said Franklin Road N. 23-45 W. 185 feet to the beginning corner and containing one and 46/100 acres more or less.

Being same piece, parcel or lot of land conveyed to the grantor and grantee by Sumie R. Thackston, Administratrix and Trustee for estate of Mrs. Annie F. Goodlett, by deed dated Feb, 14, 1927, Recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in deed book 117, at page 274.

As a part of the consideration herein the grantee assumes and agrees to pay the mortgage executed by the grantor and grantee to the Peoples National Bank in the sum of Three thousand (\$3000) Dollars, dated September 14, 1935, and recorded in R.
