Know all men by these presents, that we, R. E. Dalton and W. D. Neves, of Greenville South Carolina, the owners and holders of a certain judgment against John T. Williams, dated August 20, 1926, in the sum of \$290.60, as evidenced by Judgment Roll #u-2725, on file in the Office of Clerk of Court for Greenville County, S. C., for value received, hereby release and forever discharge the following described premises from the lien of said judgment, to wit:-

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the improvements thereon, or to be erected thereon, situate, lying and being on the North side of National Highway No. 29, leading from Greenville to Greer (formerly Rutherford Road), about 3 miles North of Greenville County Court House, in Greenville Township, in the County of Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, being shown and delineated as Lot No. 6 of "West Croftstone Acres" as per plat of property of Agnes O. Stone and S. E. Stone, made by W. D. Neves, Engineer, in March 1917 recorded in Plat Book "E" at page 36, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at the Northwest corner of National Highway No. 29 and said unnamed street, and running thence with the western side of said unnamed street N. 7-30 W. 250.4 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 1E; thence with the line of said lot, S. 76-35 W. 249 feet to corner of Lot No. 5; thence with the line of said lot, S. 7-30 E. 264 feet to stake on National Highway No. 29; thence with the northern side of National Highway No. 29, in a Northeasterly direction 250 feet to the beginning corner."
