consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) to it in  
hand paid by George E. Ford, the receipt whereof is  
hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell  
and release unto the said George E. Ford, his heirs  
and assigns forever,

All that certain lot or parcel of land situate  
lying and being in Greenville Township, County of  
Greenville and State of South Carolina, near the in-  
corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and being known  
and designated as Lot no 25 of Glenview Grove Park, and  
having, according to survey made by Dalton & Neves,  
Engineers, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

(1) Beginning at an iron pipe on the southern side  
of the Laurens Road, which iron pipe is 50.13 feet west  
of Coolidge Avenue, and running thence with said  
Laurens Road, N. 70.03 W. 50.13 feet to an iron pipe  
in line of Lot no 26; thence with line of that lot  
S. 15.48 W. 158.2 feet to an iron pipe in line of  
Lot no 23; thence with line of that lot S. 74.12 E. 50  
feet to an iron pipe corner of Lot no 24; thence with  
line of that lot S. 15.48 E. 154.1 feet to an iron pipe on  
the south side of the Laurens Road, the point of beginning.
