lying about 25 miles south of Greenville Court House, and west of the Augusta Road, bounded by Cooley Bridge Road on the north, on the east by lands of the grantor, on the south by lands of Mrs. Bettie Burton and on the west by lands of Dr. J. P. Knight, and Ben D. Davenport and the Jesse French lands; represented by a plat made by W. M. Nasn, dated September 30, 1936, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book D, page 215, said land containing 167.15 acres, More or less, according to said plat, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at Dr. Knight's corner, on the Cooley Bridge Road, and running thence in a general southwest direction as shown by said plat with the line of Dr. J. P. Knight, and the line of Ben D. Davenport, and the line of the Jesse French land and along Beaver Dam Creek to the mouth of Burton Branch; thence up Burton Branch in a general easterly direction according to said plat 44.92 chains; thence following the lines of said plat to the Cooley Bridge Road and more fully described by reference to said plat, being a part of the land heretofore conveyed to me by the grantee, J. D. McCullough, by his deed recorded in Deed Book 176, page 236, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, said plat has a frontage on Cooley Bridge Road as shown by said plat.
