Hannah Gaston.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the town of Travelers Rest, about nine miles north of Greenville County, on the East side of the Buncombe Road, or Main St., in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid, being lots #9 and 10 as represented on plat made by E. M. Hunt, Surveyor, and dated March and May 1891 of the lands of R. W. Anderson, deceased, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on said Main St. or Buncombe Road and running S. 2 1/2 E. 100 feet to a stake on corner of A. M. Gilreath's lot, formerly owned by L. B. Johnson, now owned by T. J. Watson; thence N. 87 1/2 E. 337 feet to a stake on East side of branch; thence N. 2 1/2 W. 100 feet to a stake on West side of branch; thence S. 87 1/2 W. 337 feet to the beginning corner and containing 33,700 sq. feet, more or less.

Also: All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the town of Travelers Rest, County and State aforesaid about 9 miles north of the city of Greenville and having the following metes and bounds, adjoining lands of J. H. Bridwell and others.

Beginning at a stake or stone on Buncombe Road; thence along same S. 2 1/2 E. 30 feet to iron pin; thence N. 87 1/2 E. 347 feet to a stone or iron pin on branch; thence down same N. 10 E. 30 feet to stone; thence S. 87 1/2 W. 349 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lots conveyed to me by Dr. Chas. P. Benson by deed dated March 25, 1930 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 154, at page 328.

Also: All those certain tracts of land in Bates Township, Greenville County, S. C.

(1) That tract of land known as a part of the land conveyed to J. H. Green by G.W. Bishop, adjoining lands of J. H. Green, G. W. Bishop and others. Beginning on a stone on the east side of Buncombe Road, and running thence S. 68 E. 19.33 to an iron pin, thence N. 2 1/2 W. 3.50 to a stone nm; thence N. 71 1/2 W. 19.30 to a stone in Buncombe Road; thence S. 15 1/2 E. 2.50 to the beginning corner, containing 5 acres, more or less.

(2) That tract of land on Cat Mail Branch waters of Enoree River, about 11 miles north of Greenville County Court House, S. C. on both sides of Buncombe Road, and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a stone on the East side of Buncombe Road, and running thence S. 42 1/2 E. 6.93 ch. to a stake in Cat Mail Branch; thence down and with the meanderings of said branch as a line S. 36 ch. to a stake; thence S. 59 1/2 E. 4.85 to a stake (Cat Mail Branch is to be turned on this line); thence S. 9 1/2 E. 8.14 to a pin; thence E. 6.30 chs. to a stone; thence N. 23 W. 2.62 chs. to a stone; thence N. 26 E. 10.10 chs. to a stone; thence N. 68 1/2 W. 200 chs. to the beginning corner, and containing 19 1/2 acres, more or less.

(3) That tract of land known as part of land conveyed to Cain Shelton by deed from Rubin Bishop, adjoining lands of Cain Shelton, Hampton Glenn, et al. Beginning at a stone, thence running N. 68 1/2 E. 17.00 ch. to a stone; thence S. 37 1/2 E. 31 links to a stone nm; thence S. 64 1/2 W. 16.30 to a stone om; thence S. 5 E. 3.4 to a stone om; thence N. 22 1/2 W. 5.10 to the beginning corner, containing 2.6 acres, more or less; Being the same property conveyed to me by W. A. Hopkins, as Receiver of the Farmers Bank of Travelers Rest, S. C.
