"all that piece, parcel and tract of land lying, being and situate in the State and County aforesaid containing thirty-five acres more or less and bounded by lands of Savannah Jordan, John Cothran, Thomas O. Cooley, Willis Sedbarn, William Bruce and N. E. Cooley. Is on the Cooley Bridge Road. Is about three miles from Tony Creek Post Office, in the State and County aforesaid, and is part of a tract of land of 268 acres formerly owned by Col. R. B. Higon, said deed is recorded in Book E. E. at page 329."

also, all that piece, parcel and tract of land situate in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid and Dundellin Township containing five and one-fourth acres, more or less, bounded by lands of J. A. Cothran, J. P. Woodson and J. A.
