of the Thomas L. Woodside Heirs property, said subdivision
being known as "Woodside Circle," a plot of which is re-

book "E," at page 217. The said lots being known on
said plat as lots Nos. 92, 93 and 94, having a frontage
of 25 feet each on South Woodside Circle and a depth
