Mrs. Nora Sherrill, her successors and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the county and state aforesaid, on the south side of Buncombe Street, in ward one of the City of Greenville, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at a iron pin on the south side of Buncombe Street at the corner of Mrs. Gilreath's lot and running thence along the line of Buncombe street sixty (60) feet to a stake 3x, at the corner of a lot now or formerly belonging to Mrs. Latimer; thence along the line of the said Latimer lot in a southerly direction one hundred thirty-eight (138) feet to a stake 3x; thence in a westerly direction sixty-seven (67) feet to a corner of Mrs. Gilreath's lot; thence along the Gilreath line forty six (46) feet to a bend in the said line; thence along the balance of said line one hundred twenty two (122) feet to the beginning corner on the south side of Buncombe Street, being the same lot conveyed by Mary J. Latimer to Henry W. Stroud, on January 7th, 1890, deed recorded in Vol. VV at page 414, the said Henry W. Stroud having devised the property unto Maria Stroud for life and at her death unto Alice Elms and Nora Sherrill, the said Alice Elms having conveyed her interest unto Mrs. Nora Sherrill, and being in all respects the same property conveyed by the said Mrs. Nora Sherrill to the said Sloan S. Sherrill, by deed dated February 10, 1933, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Vol. 115, page 349.
