(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Pine City Company of the Carolinas Inc.  
 All that certain tract, parcel or lot of land situate,  
 lying and being on the east side of the New Burcomie Road, and being a portion of Lot no. 71  
 on plat of proprietors of J. M. Perry, recorded in Plat  
 Book 3, lot 71, 37' x 116' 3" revised plat recorded in  
 Plat Book 4, page 184, R. M. C. office for Greenville  
 County, said tract more particularly described as  
 follows to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side  
 of Clayton Street, joint corner of Clayton Street and  
 Old Paris Mountain Road, and running thence  
 along Clayton Street S. 58-30 W. approximately 200 feet,  
 more or less, to right of way of Burcomie Road; thence  
 along Burcomie Road in a southerly direction 56  
 feet more or less, to a point (which is a joint corner  
 with a small triangular piece of property owned by  
 J. M. Perry); thence along line of property of J. M.  
 Perry S. 31-30 E. 2 feet, more or less, to an iron pin  
 northwest corner of lot no. 72; thence along joint line  
 of lots nos. 71 and 72, N. 58-30 E. 189.3 feet to an iron  
 pin on Old Paris Mountain Road, thence N. 1-17 2d  
 75.3 feet to the beginning corner, and being Lot no. 71  
 in plat of property above referred to, less the portion
