All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situated, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid on the West side of the White Horse Road and having the following metes and bounds, and courses and distances. Beginning at a stake on the White Horse Road and running thence S. 50 W. 1700 ft. to a stake on line of R. H. Means; thence with said Mean's line S. 50 E. 139 1/3 ft. to a stake on said line; thence N. 50 E. 1705 feet to a stake on West side of White Horse Road; thence N. 50 W. 134.3 feet to the beginning corner and being center one-third of the tract of land conveyed to us and the grantee herein by Albert W. Watson by deed bearing date the 13th day of June 1913, and recorded in the R. L. C. Office for said County in Book Vol. 18, page 430, and containing 5.35 acres. Being the same tract of land conveyed to us by B. S. and Julia Freeman by deed recorded in Vol. 38, page 521, R. L. C. Office for Greenville County.

Also that tract of land on the North East side of the double track of the Sou. Railroad containing one acre, more or less, adjoining lands of B. Freeman, Mrs. Albert Watson, J. E. Means and Sou. Railroad. Beginning at mouth of Culvert, J. E. Means line and runs N. E. with branch to Mrs. Watson's line to a stake in line and branch; thence to the Sou.
