Sheppard's line 3X; thence N. 23-1/2 W. 14.46 to a stone 3X; thence N. 70-1/4 E. 16.20 to a stone 3X; thence S. 47-3/4 E. 2.50 to a stone 3X; thence N. 43-1/4 E. 9.00 to a stone 3X; thence N. 22-1/2 E. 10.72 to a stone 3X; thence S. 57-1/2 E. 14.22 to the beginning stone, containing fifty-seven (57) acres more or less bounded by lands of Isaac W.
