Being known and designated as lots no. 3 and 4 of the property of R. M. and Dora Bishop according to a plat thereof recorded in the P. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Volume 3 at pages 12 and 280 and having according to the said plat the following metes and bounds to-wit:

Lot no. 3
Beginning at an iron pin on the Mabaha line and running thence N. 49 1/2 E. 228 feet to an iron pin on a street; thence N. 61 W. 55 feet with the street to a iron pin at the corner of lot no. 4; thence S. 52.3 W. 210 feet to a iron pin; thence S. 55 E. 39 feet to the beginning corner.

Lot no. 4
Beginning at an iron pin on the Mabaha line at the corner of lot no. 3, running thence N. 52.3 E. 210 feet to a iron pin on a street; thence N. 61 W. 54 feet with the street to the Judson mill line; thence S. 52.3 W. with the Judson mill line 200 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 55 E. 59 feet to the beginning corner.
