unto the said Greenville Airport Commissionall that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

about 3 miles East of the City of Greenville on the Lowndes Hill road, containing 16.89 acres more or less as shown on plat recorded in Plat Book 4, page 189, and having the following courses and distances:

Beginning at intersection of Lowndes Hill and Wood's Lake roads, corner of lands of Sullivan and Singleton, and running thence with Wood's Lake road S. 63-30 E. 137 feet; thence still with said road S. 82-30 E. 918 feet to iron pin, Casgrove corner; thence with his line S. 16 N. 1026 feet to stone, Gertrude Smith's corner; thence with her line, Noah Poole and Lillian Marr N. 45-10 E. 1412 feet to iron pin in Lowndes Hill Road; thence with said road N. 45 E. 176.10 feet to beginning corner.
