All that parcel, tract or lot of land, being in
which Springs Township, County and State afore-
said, lying on south bank of Mountain Creek,
Branch waters of Enore River, adjoining lands
of H. P. Bull, and other lands of the grantor, and
having the following metes and bounds:—
Beginning at corner post on south-west corner
of Bridge over Mountain Creek on Rutherford Road,
thence with said road S. 22 1/4 E. 8.64 chains to a
point on east side of said road, thence S. 26 1/4
W. 9.59 chains to point on west side of road,
thence S. 37 1/4 W. 8.74 chains to a point on west
side of Rutherford Road, thence N. 15 1/4 E. 11.62 to a
stone on west side old Rutherford Road, thence
N. 61° 10' W. 5.45 chains to stone on steep hillside,
thence S 15 1/4 W. 8.64 chains to iron pin on north side
of upland ditch, thence N. 65 1/2 W. 3.20 chains to
iron pin on north side of ditch, thence N. 42 W.
5.55 chains to a point on west side of gully,
thence N. 8 E. 2.93 chains to stone on west side of
gully, thence N. 25 E. 2.75 to stone on east side of
fish pond branch, thence N. 51 1/4 W. 9.75 to stone
at pine, thence N. 20 1/2 E. 6.04 to a point on south
bank of Mountain Creek, thence down the meanders
of said creek to the beginning corner, and containing
twentyone and one-tenth acres more or less, according
to survey made by J. Earle Freeman Oct. 30, 1937.
