All that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows: Being the lot situated just outside of the city limits of the city of Greenville and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on Mountain View Avenue 345 feet from the southeast corner of Mountain View Avenue, and a 15 foot alley, and thence running with Mountain View Avenue, S. 80-15 E. 60 feet; thence S. 62 1/2 W. 180 feet; thence N. 80-15 E. 60 feet with the line of another lot, thence back line of said lot N. 9-45 E. 180 feet to the beginning corner on Mountain View Avenue, and being part of a lot sold to said Lillie J.
