NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of *One Hundred (\$100.00)* Dollars, to me paid by the said *George M. Smith*

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANT, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said *George M. Smith*

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about seven miles south of Greenville, S. C., adjoining lands of John Jacob Smith, Wm. Henderson and others containing 0.74 acres of land, more or less, and being the same tract of land conveyed to John L. Henderson by deed dated Nov. 28, 1914 by J. M. Pike, said deed being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in deed book 92 page 141
