I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, *People's Building and Loan Association, a Corporation*on or about the 11/10 day of October, in the year of  
our Lord nineteen hundred and twelve, exhibited his complaint in the Court of  
Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against A. J. Patrick, et al.demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 15/11/12  
day of November, 1937, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Deree

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of  
One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars,  
to me paid by the said Eula Johnson,the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the  
said Eula Johnsonall that certain piece, parcel and lot of land  
lying, lying situated in Greenville County, in the  
State of South Carolina, as follows, to wit: Being  
known and designated as part of Lot no. 116, Block  
9 of East Park as shown on plat of said property  
recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville  
County in Plat Book A, Page 383, more fully  
described as follows:Beginning at a stake on the northeast side of  
Ebaugh Avenue 30 feet from the right-of-way of S. 18  
W. 16. Proj. Company running thence with line of Lot  
no. 115, as shown on said plat N. 35° 00' E. 140 feet to a  
stake in line of Lot no. 115, thence N. 57° 45' W. 50 feet to
