I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS;

WHEREAS, The First Carolinas Joint Stock Land Bank of Columbia,

on or about the 20th day of September, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty, exhibited <sup>168</sup> complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against J. D. Spence, et al.

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 16th day of October, 19<sup>32</sup>, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. being at that price the highest bidder therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and no/100 (\$200.00) Dollars,

to me paid by the said B. H. Burdette,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said B. H. Burdette,

"All the right, title and interest (legal or equitable) which J. D. Spence might have acquired and may yet have by reason of a contract of sale entered into between him and the First Carolinas Joint Stock Land Bank of Columbia as of date Dec. 20, 1928, in and to all tract certain place, or tract of land, situate, lying and being in Grove Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, containing four hundred (400) acres, more or less, being bounded on the North by lands of C. B. Tarrant and Payne, east by the lands of J. J. Cleveland estate, south by the lands of A. C. Norris, Nesbit and Trembridge and west by the S. & G. Railroad line, and having such shape, metes, courses and dimensions as will more fully appear by reference to a plat thereof made by William F. Lee, Surveyor, January 11, 1919, and being the same tract of land conveyed to John W. Davis and John A. Norris by E. Inman, Master for Greenville County, S.
