the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the  
said S. M. Jones .....

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of  
South Carolina, on the North side of Palmetto Street, near the Cedar Lane Road, fronting  
said Palmetto Street 70 feet with a depth of 175 feet and known and designated as lot  
No. 34 in the Subdivision of the G. J. Douglass Lands, as shown on Plat recorded in  
Plat Book F, page 126.

Also all that other certain piece, parcel or lot of land in said County and  
State, on the corner of Edgemount Road and Hill Street, fronting Hill Street 78.2 feet  
and running thence along the line of Lot No. 41, 158.7 feet; thence North 123.60 feet
