All that piece parcel or tract of land in the  
County of Greenville and State of South Carolina  
in Butler Township, containing Seventy-six and 1/400  
acres as is shown by plat made by W. J. Riddle  
Surveyor, March 19, 1929, and by said survey has  
the following, meters and bounds:  
Beginning in the public road at an iron  
pin joint corner with W. J. Varden; thence S 70-30  
E. 242.9 feet along line of W. J. and J. M. Varden to a  
stone corner; thence S 73-15 W. 155.6 feet, along line of J. M. Varden  
to an iron pin; thence N. 73-15 W. 124.3 feet along  
line of lands of W. M. Varden Estate of an iron pin;  
thence S. 1-50 W. 300 feet to point corner of tract  
no. 3 of A. B. King Estate; thence N. 73-15 W. 155.6  
feet crossing branch and to an iron pin in  
road; thence N. 4-45 E. 330 feet along said road
