All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in which Springs Township, on or near the Rutherford Road on branch waters of Converse River and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stone 3x on the old Rutherford Road and running thence N. 59 W. 32.12 to a stone, thence S. 29 1/2 W. 14.80 to a stone, thence S. 50 E. 13.17 to a stone, thence S. 65 1/2 E. 33.70 to a stone on old road, thence with the road 9.38 to the beginning corner being the same conveyed to O. D. Gilbreath by C. L. Childress on the 36th day of March 1895, by deed recorded in the R. M. C.
