all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

on the West side of Augusta Road, and known and designated as lot No. 9 on plat of a survey made by R. E. Dalton, C. E., August, 1922, and described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of the Augusta Road 174 feet south of the intersection of the Mrs. Bee Spring Road and running S. 62° 27' W. 327.4 feet to an iron pin at the N. E. corner of lots numbers 12 and 13; thence S. 26° 31' E. 79.8 feet to an iron pin at the N. E. corner of lots numbers 13 and 14; thence N. 62° 27' E. 327.4 feet to an iron pin on the West side of the Augusta Road; thence N. 30° 52' W. along Augusta Road 80 feet to the beginning corner.
