(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
Annie E. Sloan, her heirs and assigns:-

That certain tract of land in Chick Springs Township, said County and State, and Beginning at a stake at intersection of Wood Street and the Old National Highway, and runs thence with the said Highway S. 79-30 E. 150 feet to a stake, Earle Duncan's corner; thence S. 19-45 W. 149 feet to a stake on W. S. Parker's line; thence with said Parker line N. 85-55 W. 147.6 feet to a stake on Wood Street; thence with Wood Street N. 17-55 E. 165 feet to the beginning corner, and known and designated as Lot No. 9 on plat of H. J. Lanford Property, and part of the same conveyed to W. P. Sloan by J. J. Wood, and by W. P. Sloan to C. E. Sloan by deed recorded 187, page 352.

Also, an undivided one half interest in and to that certain tract of land containing sixty acres, more or less, in Glassy Mt. Township, said County and State, and delineated as follows: Beginning at a Chestnut oak and runs thence in a northerly direction to line of William Massey; thence with Massey line to the Brissack land; thence along the Brissack line to the Balew Tract, poplar corner; thence with the Balew line to stone corner; thence with Balew line to corner in Bottoms; thence with Balew Line to stone on Mountain; thence with J. M. Moon Estate line to the beginning corner; also undivided one half interest in and to the following tract of land;

Beginning at a stone on the J. M. Moon Estate line, and running thence northerly with J. M. Moon Estate line to a stone on side of Creek; thence northwest to a pine; thence north-east to a black gum on J. A. Center's line; thence S. E. to a stone; thence East to a stake; thence South with Will Center's line to a red oak on branch; thence West to a stone at the lower end of the bottom at Morgan's Creek; thence south to a red oak; thence West with the J. M. Moon Estate line to the beginning corner, and containing one hundred twenty-five (125) acres, more or less.
