(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
Pearl Southerlin Sudduth.

All of our undivided interest in that certain tract parcel or lot of land lying and being  
in Highland Township, and Greenville County and in the State of South Carolina, This being the  
same land conveyed to R. A. Southerlin from L. N. Southerlin and recorded in Book D, and page 164,  
Having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances. Beginning on a stone, thence N.  
47½ E. 21.00 chains to a stone; thence N. 34 E. 7.80 to a stone; thence N. 63½ E. 19.50 to a  
stone; thence N. 64 E. to the creek; thence down said creek to a stake; thence S. 63½ W. 29.00 to  
a stone; thence S. 73 W. 12.86 to a stone; thence S. 73½ W. 14.21 to a stone the beginning corner.  
Containing fifty acres more or less.

Also, a certain tract of land lying and being in the above said county and state,  
Beginning on a stone on the W. P. Bates line, thence with said line to a Hickory on the road
