(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Piedmont and Northern Railway Company, its successors and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the Southwest side of Cagle Street, being known and designated as Lot No. 6, of Block A, as shown on plat of property of J. W. Cagle and W. L. Mauldin, prepared May 1st, 1913, by F. H. and T. G. Cunningham, recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, at pages 106 and 107 and being more particularly described, according to said plat, as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Southwest side of Cagle Street, corner of Lot No. 4, which iron pin is 102 feet from Maple Street, and running thence with the line of Lots No. 4 and 2, S. 47-03 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the East side of a 16 foot alley; thence along the East side of said alley, N. 42-57 W. 70 feet to an iron pin rear corner of Lot No. 8; thence with the line of Lot No. 8 N. 47-03 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the Southwest side of Cagle Street; thence with the Southwest side of Cagle Street, S. 42-57 E. 70 feet to the point of beginning, together with all my right, title and interest in and to that certain alley at the rear of said lot.

This is the same lot of land conveyed to me by E. Inman, Master, by deed dated September 1, 1919, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deeds Volume 59, at page 28.
