(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
Henry P. Dill, Jr.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paria Mt., Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All of our interest which is an undivided two-thirds (2/3) in that certain place, parcel, or
tract of land situate on the Southern side of the North Franklin Road, being known and
designated as tract Nos. 1, 2 and 3 of a plat of the property of Olive C. Dill, Henry P. Dill,
Mollie Sue Dill made by W. J. Riddle dated April 4, 1946 and to be recorded.

Said lots of land are more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the southern side of N. Franklin Road at the N. W. corner of tract
#1 and running thence S. 81-0 E. 482.4 ft. joint corner of tract #3 and 4; thence along the joint
line of tract #3 & 4 S. 6-10 W. 536.5 ft. to a point at the joint rear corner of tract corner
of tract #3 & 4; thence S. 88-0 W. 584.3 ft. to an iron pin; whence N. 3-24 W. 624 ft. to a
pin on the N. Franklin Road and the point of beginning.

The above described land is a portion of that conveyed to Henry P. Dill, Sr. by deed of T. W.
Bar, recorded in the R. M. O. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 5 at page 322. Olive
C. Dill, Henry P. Dill, Jr., Mollie Sue Dill, Emma Dill Forrest, and John Frank Dill are the
sole heirs at law of the said Henry P. Dill, by deed of E. Inman, Master, dated November 1945
and recorded in the R. M. O. Office of Greenville County, the interest of said Emma Dill Forrest
and John Frank Dill was conveyed to the grantee and the grantors.
