All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land on the north side of Eighth Street, in Section No. 4 of Judson Mills Village, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 12, as shown on a plat of Section No. 4 of Judson Mills Village, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, January 1941, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book K, at pages 75 and 76, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Eighth Street, joint front corner of Lots No. 11 and 12, said pin also being 74.9 feet west from the northwest corner of the intersection of Eighth Street and Hawkins Avenue, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 11, N. 1-42 W. 119.5 feet to an iron pin; thence with the rear line of Lot No. 25, S. 88-03 W. 81 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 13, S. 1-42 E. 119.5 feet to an iron pin on the north side of Eighth Street; thence with the north side of Eighth Street N. 88-03 E. 81 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same property conveyed by Judson Mills to me by deed dated March 1, 1941, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 232, page 56, and being subject to the conditions set forth in said deed.
