All that piece, parcel or lot of property in Greenville Township, State and County aforesaid
being designated as lots No. 1, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 of the property of Rosalee Smith, as shown by a
plat made by Dalton & Neves, dated October, 1941, and according to said plat having the following
metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on Lynn Street, 120 feet from the intersection of Lynn Street
and Mills Avenue, and running thence 351.2 feet to an iron pin on Brushy Creek; thence N. 45-39 W.

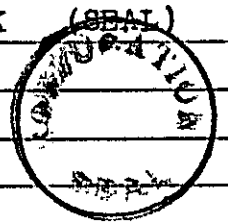
