Hazel Lee Jenkinson, and her heirs and assigns,

All our right, title, and interest, of, in and to
All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County,
State of South Carolina, on the North side of an unnamed street, near the City of Greenville,
being shown as Lot No. 1 on plat of property of J. R. Jenkinson made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor,
in April, 1940, and described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of said unnamed Street in line of property
known as "Augusta Court", and running thence with the line of said subdivision, N. 41-30 W.
153.3 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 2; thence with the line of said lot, S. 37-46 W.
150.8 feet to a stake on said unnamed street; thence with the Northern side of said unnamed
street, following the curve thereof, S. 67-23 E. 112 feet to a stake; thence N. 68-27 E. 49.1
feet to a stake; thence N. 56-52 E. 53 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described lot is a portion of the property conveyed to J. R. Jenkinson by J. G.
and Taylor McBee by deed dated July 29, 1914, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville
County, S. C., in Book of Deeds 28 at page 130. The said J. R. Jenkinson died testate and by
his will filed in Apartment 436, File 27, in the office of Probate Judge for Greenville County,
S. C., devised said property to his eight children, the grantors and grantee in this deed, who
are all of his children.
