All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, on the west side of Reedy River, beginning on stone corner 3x in Factory Road leading to Payne's Shop; thence running S. 47 W. 6 chs. 32 links to a stone on same road; 3x N. 39 W. 3 chs. 16 links to a stone 3X; thence N. 47 E. 6 chs. 32 links to a stone 3X; thence 39 E. 3 chs. 16 links to the beginning stone, corner in same road; containing 2 acres, be the same more or less, bounded all around by lands of the Reedy River Mfg. Co., as more fully appears by reference to deed recorded in the R. M. C.
