

their parent's portion per stirpes and not per capita; and in the event of the death of my said wife leaving neither surviving child of myself and my said wife nor children of any child of myself and my said wife, then the entire estate and property above described shall revert to me in fee simple forever and, if I shall have predeceased my said wife, to my heirs at law forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular said premises unto the said Ellen Wiggins Davenport, the life tenant, and the children begotten of the marriage of Dan D. Davenport and Ellen Wiggins Davenport as shall survive the said Ellen Wiggins Davenport and all others who shall take hereunder, and their heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
