## TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

All that certain tract or parcel of land situate in Gantt Township, County and State aforesaid, containing 18.85 acres, more or less, being the same property as that conveyed to the within grantor by George Pickett by deed dated January 15th, 1906, recorded in the R.
