(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
W. C. Hughey, his heirs and assigns,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,  
being lot No. 11 of the property of William W. Bryson, according to a plat made by W. C. Adkins,  
November 22, 1940; said land lies near the Town of Piedmont, South Carolina, just off the Greenville-  
Piedmont Highway, known as Highway No. 29, and this lot contains one and two-tenths (1.2) acre,  
more or less, and is more fully described as follows;

Beginning at a point on an unnamed road, joint corner of lots Nos. 10 and 11 of said  
property, according to said plat, and running thence along said road, S. 26-30 W. 4 chains, 45 links  
to a stake on a branch; thence N. 50-45 W. 2 chains, 45 links, to a stake, corner of lot No. 11  
and other property of William W. Bryson; thence along joint line of lot No. 11 and other property
