Plat Book G, at page 197, reference to said plat being craved for a more complete description of
these lots.
These are the same lots which were conveyed to W. D. Parrish and $^{\mathrm{T}}$. C. Gower by W. B.
McDaniel December 24, 1927, by deed recorded in Vol. 114 at page 31, a one-third interest in said
property having been thereafter conveyed by Parrish & Gower to C. B. Martin March 26, 1928, by deed
recorded in Vol. 109, at p. 367, my husband, W. D. Parrish, having thereafter died owning a one-
third interest in said property, which was devised to me by his last will and testament, as will be
shown by reference to the records in the office of Judge of Probate for Greenville County. The
deed to this property is made by me individually and as executrix of the estate of W. D. Parrish.
2. Also, all my one-third interest in and to lots 4, 6, and 7, as shown by plat of
property of Parrish, Gower & Martin made by Dalton & Neves April, 1930, and recorded in Plat Book
H, page 176.
Also, the fellowing small tract of land which is also shown on the above plat recorded
in Plat Book H at page 176, which is bounded and described as follows:
Beginning at a point on Pearl Avenue at the intersection of Brook Drive and running

pay any paving assessments chargeable against the property abutting on Watts Avenue.
