All that piece, part or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina. and lying north of Bearden Avenue of the Town of Greer, and designated as Lot No. 3 on plat of the B. T. Green property, prepared by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, 11-2-40, and having the following courses and distances:-

Beginning at the northwestern corner of Lot No. 2 on said plat, on the Davenport line, and runs thence therewith N. 30° W. 97.6 feet to i. p., thence N. 87° 46' E. 117 feet to iron pin; thence S. 1° 45' E. 80 feet, more or less; then skipp across alley way to iron pin, and beginning again at northeastern corner of lot No. 1 on said plat, and runs thence N. 81° 09' W. 50 feet to pin; then S. 1° 45' E. 15 feet; thence N. 81° 09' W. 59 feet, and bounded West by Davenport; North by Berry and others; East by Berry and South by Lots 1 and 2 on said plat;
